### Teaching Dance in Schools

Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008, amateur DanceSport competitors in the DanceSport Alberta region, who are also certified school teachers, may instruct the basic fundamentals of DanceSport steps to school children without it impacting their amateur status.

This is provided that

- the activity is only offered to children (Kindergarten to Grade 12) in the Provincial school system at which the teacher is employed.
- the activity is only for the encouragement of dancing and not for the purposes of training the children for competition.
- the activity does not result in additional compensation for the amateur who is conducting the activity.

Amateur competitors who are also certified school teachers and are interested in setting up such activities will need to notify DanceSport Alberta that they are doing so.
