Effective September 1, 2008

Changes to the Naming of Age Categories

The following changes to the naming of age categories have been approved at the national and regional levels for DanceSport competitors in Canada.

Effective September 1st, 2008 the following designations will change in the DanceSport Alberta Region,

Old Naming Designation

Adult (19+ years)
Senior I (35+ years)
Senior II (45+ years)
Senior III (55+ years)

New Naming Designation

Adult (no change)
Adult II (35+ years)
Adult III (45+ years)
Adult IV (55+ years)

- DanceSport rules and age classifications for competitions now need to refer to the new designations.
- DanceSport organizers will need to implement the new designations starting this September 2008 and may refer to both during the one year transition period.
- The Senior designation will remain in use at the International DanceSport Federation Level for now. Naming designations for all other age classifications stay as they are.
