### Championship level Amateur Teaching Eligibility

In addition to the existing rules of eligibility for Championship level dancers to teach DanceSport (see CADA Rule 8.03) the following changes have been approved at the national level.

- All Adult II (Senior I) Championship finalists at the Canadian Closed Championship are eligible to teach DanceSport provided there was a quarter final in the event and they register and complete their training as outlined in the CADA rules. If less than a quarter final that the top 3 couples are eligible, see CADA rules 8.03 for details.
- The top three Adult III (Senior II) Championship finalists at the Canadian Closed Championship are eligible to teach DanceSport provided they register and complete their training as outlined in the CADA rules.
- Championship level amateurs who are qualified to teach no longer need to re-qualify in a Canadian Closed final every two years.
